## FIRST CLUB EVENT      MT. MACEDON OUTING

Club Captain, Winston Kim's car was sporting a new black powder coated rollbar, Cameron Greig had a specially made seat so that he can fit in the car (he's 6'4") whilst others had all sorts of innovative knick knacks from central locking to body styling kits.

By mid afternoon members began to wander home with a number of 'hard core' Clubbers having settled in beside the open fire sipping Irish Coffees before venturing into the cold.

It was a terrific day for meeting other Club members, making new friends and discussing what type of events members would like their committee to organise. If the camaraderie shown on Sunday the 2nd is any indication, I can assure you that the MX-5 Club will continue to be one big happy, successful family.


