

## The Red & White Run

Starting point: McDonald's, Berwick South (cnr Clyde Road & Homestead Road)



0.5	TR	into <b>Old Cheese Factory</b> car park park where you can and take a wander around the grounds (20 minutes)	
Reset odometer as you leave the Old Cheese Factory car park			
0.0	TL	from car park into <b>Homestead Rd</b>	0.3
0.3	so	through roundabout	0.2
0.5	TL	Clyde Rd bunch up into two lanes in Clyde Road so we get as many as possible across Princes Hwy at the lights	2.7
3.2	VR	across Princes Hwy into <b>Lyall Rd, Berwick</b> towards Harkaway	0.6
3.8	so	through roundabout Regroup on left if needed	0.5
4.3	TR	at roundabout, into Inglis Rd	2.3

For BYO picnickers, there's a great spot at "JAC Russell Park" (with BBQ & rotunda)

- From "Forest Edge", continue towards Gembrook
- TR into Main Road, Gembrook [C412]; the park is in the town centre, 300m down on the right next to Gembrook "Puffing Billy" station, Main Road, Gembrook (Melway 312 K10)
- Toilets are 500m down Redwood Road (opposite park), in the Gembrook Bushland Park
